Looking For Lulu

Windsor Light Music Theatre is looking for a young actress to play the role of Lulu in their upcoming production of *Waitress*. The young actress must be available for all rehearsals listed below along with the production dates.

Character Description

Lulu (she/her; all ethnicities; youth - looks/acts about 4 or 5 years of age) Lulu is a sweet and carefree girl of about 4 years old. Waitress is a musical about Jenna, a small-town waitress who puts her passion into incredible pie-baking, and finds the strength to pursue a long-abandoned dream. Lulu is the daughter of Jenna and Earl. Lulu appears in the final scene of the musical and in a few brief moments throughout the show.
